Growing number of affected persons of Lucknow from COVID-19, is very disturbing development. All the Members working in the Tribunal are above 60 years. In the Tribunal most of lawyers have also crossed age of 60. Litigants from all over state come to Lucknow to attend their cases. Covid-19 has assumed a very dangerous proportion. Keeping in view the safety of all concerned and growing number of patients of COVID-19, I direct that Tribunal shall remain closed from 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2020 till 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. Situation will be again reviewed on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2020.

In view of loss of 7 working days, Tribunal shall remain open on 18.04.2020, 25.4.2020, 02.05.2020, 16.05.2020, 30.05.2020, 16.06.2020 and 17.06.2020.
